

## ESP Indicators for Moderators



When a feature is in use, a yellow halo appears around the icon being used next to the Participants name.

- When there is a delay in delivery of Audio, Whiteboard, Application Sharing, and Video Camera content, ESP indicators lights alert the Moderator of the delay. These indicators are dynamic and update during the session.
- A **red light** next to a name indicates the person has not received the Whiteboard screen content. This light disappears once the Participant has received the content.
- An **orange light** next to a name indicates the person is still receiving the Whiteboard content. This light will disappear once the Participant has received all of the content.

By keeping an eye on the indicators, you can adjust the pace of your session.

## Whiteboard ESP Indicators

The red and orange indicators show a delay in Audio, Whiteboard and Video Camera content for the Moderator and two Participants. The yellow glow around the chat bubble indicates participants are text chatting.

## Application Sharing ESP Indicators

While using Application Sharing, the orange and red indicator lights represent the length of the delay.

- Indicator lights next to the Moderator's name means there is a backlog of information to send to the server.
- Both red and orange lights next to a Participant's name indicate more of a delay when compared with a Participant with just an orange light.
- When there are no indicator lights, it means the Participant's Application Sharing display is in sync with the person hosting Application Sharing.
